The season is fully recorded in P.Kings S.C. Annual. There the averages include the two internal matches against the 2<sup>nd</sup> of the School and the 16 of the Club, but appear to miss out some of the scores made against the Housars. I have chosen to omit all internal games but to include games against outside XI's unless the FP XI is obviously a scratch or A XI.

There exists the usual wrong over aliases. Often the averages disclose the player concerned; sometimes a second newspaper names the player.

King states that the active members number 37 with 28 honorary members.

W.W. Smith, of Gairmount, was an F.P. and often appears in the FP XI

Glasgow Caledonian could not raise an XI on 11 June and the day was taken over by the Club game. Later they only brought 9 through.

In the Carlton match of 18 June their last man came in within four minutes of time but fell to the first ball of the next over.

The Clydesdale match of 16 July was stopped by a heavy thunderstorm, heavy enough to burst the drains in the Park.

In the Kelso match of 23 July W.A. M'Intosh, fielding at leg, had a finger broken trying to catch a very hard hit by D. Maclean.
