Glasgow Caledonian arrived two short but Arch. Parkours turned out to give them 10 men. A. Wood was stumped off the second last ball

The umpiring at Dalkeith was reported as " on both sides was simply disgraceful and was the subject of much comment among both players and spectators "

Some 2000 spectators watched the match against the Dragons (who had a good team) but right up to 1914 the club were always supported by a good crowd from the High Street and Canongate areas

The Clydesdale game in Edinburgh was finished by a thunderstorm

The Edinburgh Caledonian teams of the 1860's contained many FPs, notably the Sandersons and A. Buchanan (who married the only Sanderson daughter). Round about 1868 this group came over to the FP XI and the Caledonian club more or less collapsed.
