I have not included two internal games: 24 Apr. RMS XI v RMS XII and 20 July: Moderns v. Ancients. The account in King's Annual would appear to include some such games for the averages.

A team from Canada toured Britain; this party included one or two Scottish public schoolboys. One of the party was eventually arrested as a deserter from the Army. At Holyrood Treloar, keeping wicket to the fast bowling of T. Jordan, had one of the small bones of his arm broken.

I have included the fill up match in the averages and results. In this inning AL Wood lost 3 balls by hitting 2 into the Palace grounds and 1 into the Brewhay.

Against Grange at Raeburn Place W Gladwin and R. Mitchell batted 15 mins. past time 13 let Grange win but remained unbeaten to gain a draw.

The West appear to have had only 10 players at Holyrood; this is also true for Selkirk.

P. King's Annual contains a set of averages which I cannot reconcile with those obtained from the newspapers. It would appear that the Annual has included the Ancients v. Moderns game, an internal members game. I, however, have included the fillup match played against the Canadians.

A.L. Wood is recorded as bowling slowly. Against the Canadians he cost the Club three lost balls by hitting two into the Palace grounds and one into the Broadway.
