C.D. Stuart is noted as bowling underhands. He was a worthy member of Nat Watt's Hambros - the R.H.S. 1<sup>st</sup> XI of that time - and the father of two future rugby caps, one of whom (C.D. Stuart jr) is still alive in 1977.

G. Muir, last year's colt and slow bowler, had returned from London. J.M. Fullerton was captain of the A. XI.

The Annual Dinner was held on 29 Nov. 83. It was noted that the best P.P. batsman was Tom Johnston who totalled 497 runs at an average of 35.7, with 2 centuries; an indication of what was to come as he was probably the best bat to come out of the school.
