## **Net Booking Procedures and Terms & Conditions**

All Net sessions must be pre-booked using the Club's (Setmore) Booking System. In booking your net session, you agree to be bound by the following terms and conditions. Your attention is also drawn to the **Net Protocol** at the end of this document. Please read the following carefully, as failure to adhere to these may result in net booking privileges being withdrawn:-

- The following terms and conditions are compliant with the Cricket Scotland guidelines which were announced on 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2020. The club reserves the right to amend these at any time in line with further CS guidance which may be released – follow all Covid 19 guidelines issued by Cricket Scotland - <a href="http://www.cricketscotland.com/covid-19-return-to-cricket/">http://www.cricketscotland.com/covid-19-return-to-cricket/</a>
- In line with current Scottish Government guidance, if you are symptomatic, living in a household with a possible COVID-19 infection or if you are classified as extremely vulnerable on health grounds, you should remain at home and follow Government guidance.
- Juniors in current (just finished) School years P5-S6 can use the nets with members of their own household or with members from up to 2 other households at any one time per day. A maximum of 4 players can participate in a session, inc 1 Parent / Guardian who must be present to run the session
- Parent / Guardian not required to be present for those in current School years \$4-\$6.
- Juniors in current School years P5-S6 can use the Nets for a 1:1 Session with a Coach up to 2 players from same Household – Parent / Guardian not required.
- Social distancing of at least two metres must be maintained at all times (unless all participants are members of the same household).
- Wash hands at home before and after using the outdoor facilities. Bring your own hand sanitiser.
- Use own equipment. We will not be providing club equipment apart from stumps.
- No saliva or sweat should come into contact with the ball at any time.
- The Clubhouse and Changing Rooms will be closed and no Toilet facilities will be available.
- Members are using nets at their own risk.
- Try not to arrive too early, aim to arrive at the start of your slot to help with social distancing.
- Bring your own playing/training equipment including balls.
- Bring your own filled drinking bottles.
- All litter must be removed from the ground at end of session.
- Avoid touching anything as much as possible whilst on club premises
- Do not overstay your allocated time slot, you should be clear of the area by the time the next users arrive.
- Do not stay to socialise and no spectators permitted.
- As always, the health and safety of participants is paramount please ensure those using the nets minimise the risk
  of injury (wear helmets, pads etc).

## **Net Protocol (may be viewed with Ground Map)**

- Arrive by main entrance on Ferry Road (there is no access by East Fettes Avenue).
- Car Parking & Drop Off in Car Park to immediate left on entering ground.
- Proceed to Waiting Area.
- When notified by Club Representative deposit Kit in the identified Kit Area.
- Proceed to designated Net for 50 minute Net Session.
- Each Net marked with white line across middle batter half & bowler half which must be complied with where distancing applies.
- Batter must return all balls in his / her half of Net with bat or foot ball **must not** be picked up by hand.
- For Nets of more than 1 Household please note distanced box markings for those waiting to bowl.
- For Nets of more than 1 Household all players to bowl with their own bowl.
- Players must refrain from fielding any ball other than their own.
- Players going into bat must change in Kit Area and for Nets of more than 1 Household all players must maintain distancing at changeover.
- Please ensure social distancing at all times you are at the club.
